Senior Late Arrival/Early Dismissal Privilege
Authorization Form

To be a senior, a student must have earned credits towards graduation. Seniors have the additional responsibilities of being student leaders and are accorded the following privileges:

- A. All seniors who are unassigned for the first class that meets on a particular day may arrive to school by 8:16 a.m. It is the responsibility of the individual to sign-in to school in the main office and be on time for the second period that meets each day.
- B. Seniors who have no further classes or scheduled obligations after F Period may leave school after completing their daily scheduled program. It is the responsibility of the individuals to present their blue card to any staff member when asked for verification of grade status. **Students leaving school early must leave school grounds (unless under the supervision of a staff member) and not return before 2:08 p.m. unless they sign in at the main office.**

The privileges stated above are extended to each senior with written verification of approval from a custodial parent/guardian and are subject to removal on an individual basis on each student's adherence to the conditions stated above. Should a student's privileges be revoked, the student will be informed of such at an informal meeting with their assistant principal.
