The meeting was called to order by Chairman Robert Jellen at 5:00 p.m.

Mr. DeLoreto provided the committee with a proposal to expand class offerings at E.O. Smith into the evening. The classes would be taught by certified teachers primarily from E.O. Smith High School. Ms. Veronneau asked what mathematics courses would be offered in the evening and wanted the committee members to be sure that core mathematics courses needed for graduation would be offered at night. It was understood that the rate of pay for teachers evening division would have to be negotiated with the EO Smith high school teachers Association. Mr. DeLoreto indicated to the committee that he would return with more information as the details get worked out with Eastern Connecticut State University. Mr. Silva noted that he would be taking the proposal to the board's finance committee at a future meeting for further review.

DeLoreto reported on the progress. The English and social studies departments are having implementing the new ninth grade B level classes. He noted that 'assistance classes' are being offered to those students who are in need of more tutorial help to be successful in the regular classroom. Although it is labor-intensive the new "B level" initiative appears to be successful.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:55 p.m.
