

# NEW THIS YEAR: PowerSchool Learning (PLearning)

Beginning this school year, E.O. Smith will be using PLearning as the only online platform to support learning in all classes. PLearning is integrated with PowerSchool and replaces all other online learning platforms such as Moodle, Google Classroom, Wix, etc. We will be emailing tips and updates about program features as we progress through the year to help acclimate you to PLearning.

**STUDENTS** will be able to access grades, class information, assignments and calendars from a single sign-in through PLearning or PowerSchool. Students will also receive notifications and email messages from teachers, advisors, counselors and administration to their E.O. Smith account. It is very important that students regularly check their school email accounts.

**PARENTS** will use a separate log-in to access PLearning. This will allow parents to see supporting materials (course expectations, assignments, calendars, videos, links, etc.). Parents will also be able to elect to receive notifications and emails.

## HOW TO ACCESS PLearning

**Parents** will need to retrieve their initial PLearning password from inside PowerSchool, under School Information (see graphic to right). Using this password and their PowerSchool username, they can sign into PLearning using this link:

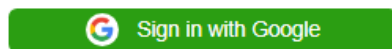

Enter this username and password on the "Sign in with your PLearning account" – see graphic below (Note: parents cannot access through the Sign-in with Google login option).

**Students** may access PLearning through their regular Power School login or may access it directly using the "Sign in with Google" option.
